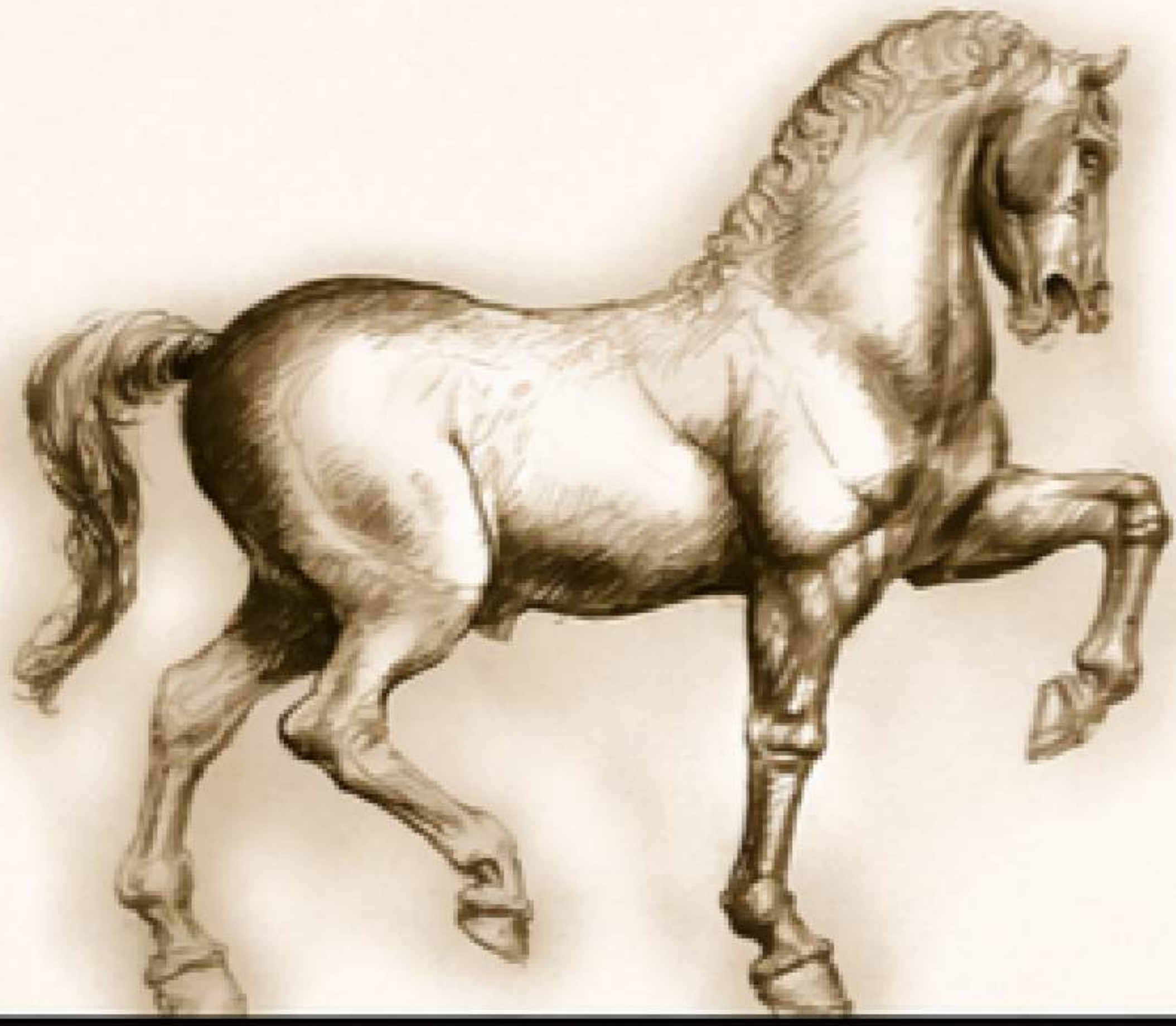

# **RULES & REGULATIONS**

## **ENTRIES**

1. Saturday/Sunday Shows – Entries close on the Tuesday at 11:59pm before show.
2. Sunday/Monday Shows – Entries close on the Wednesday at 11:59pm before show.
3. Entries received after due date will be charged \$20 late entry fee. Day of entries will not be accepted.

4. All accounts must be closed out at the end of the day of show. 3% charged on all accounts not closed by 10am day after show. All Major credit/debit cards (Swipe, insert, or tap), e-transfer ([payment@meadowlarkestables.com](mailto:payment@meadowlarkestables.com)), or cash is accepted in person, you can also 'Checkout' online in your SGL account. Please don't pay/check out until after the competitor is finished showing for the day. PRIZE MONEY WILL ONLY BE PAID OUT AS A DEDUCTION FROM YOUR INVOICE.
5. Any no-shows and complete scratches (did not ride on show grounds) will be charged a nonrefundable office fee of \$25+hst PLUS a scratch fee of \$25+hst PLUS Stall if requested on entry.
6. NOTE TO TRAINERS - Please make sure your/client's entries has your name down as a trainer. This will help order of goes/ ingate staff & high point year-end trainer awards.
7. Back Numbers will be available for pick-up on the table by the office if ALL SIGNATURES ARE SIGNED ON YOUR ENTRY FORM, IF YOU DON'T SEE YOUR NUMBER, PLEASE COME INTO THE OFFICE TO SIGN PAPER FORMS TO RECEIVE YOUR NUMBERS
8. To see the order of goes and start times - please visit <https://meadowlarke.showgroundslive.com/show-schedule/> The show will be LIVE on SGL, please check on the 'Ring Status' to check for updates.

## **COMPETITION RULES**

1. ASTM approved helmets mandatory for all riders.
2. Proper show attire required.
3. Horses are not required to be braided for Hunter divisions but is recommended.
4. Numbers must be worn and visible at all times while mounted.
5. Fall of rider in show ring = elimination.
6. All dogs must be leashed.
7. Golf Carts, Motorbikes & E-scooters are allowed for licensed drivers.
8. For all other concerns, Equestrian Canada rules apply.

# ***RULES & REGULATIONS CONT'D***

## ***ADD/SCRATCH***

1. Office & Scratch fees only apply if scratches are received as follows:  
Hunter/Beginner ring – before the start of the division.  
Jumper ring – before the start of each class.  
If scratches are not received in the above time frame, FULL entry fees will be due.
2. Add/Scratches MUST be done at the office.
3. Telling the ingate that you are scratching is not considered an official scratch.
4. Day-of show scratch fee (\$25+hst) will apply if not entered in any classes.

## ***MANAGEMENT***

1. Management reserves the right to cancel, modify, combine, or split any class.
2. Management also reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show, or to move classes to another ring.
3. Meadowlarke Stables Inc., the competition and their officials, directors, employees, volunteers and agents harmless from all claims including for any injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, volunteers or agents of Meadowlarke Stables Inc..
4. We do not do any drug testing HOWEVER if a horse appears doped up, it will be eliminated from competition at management's discretion.
5. Adult pony riders are allowed to show but must be appropriate height/weight for pony competing.
6. Well-behaved Stallions are allowed, but Management must be notified and approve. Any unruly behavior by a stallion will be grounds for dismissal from either show ring and/or anywhere on show grounds.
7. Horses are to be limited to 8 hunter/jumper/beginner classes per day excluding Leadline classes.
8. In the event of TRAINER CONFLICT, the ring that takes priority for that day will be announced and posted in the office. It is expected that a rider waiting for their trainer must be warmed up, ready to show and waiting at the ingate. It is not acceptable to hold a ring for a hack, flat or undersaddle class.

## ***PRIZES***

1. Ribbons to 8th in all divisions.
2. Ribbons will be available to pick up at the ingate.
3. Champion/Reserve Champions at each show are calculated as follows:  
7,5,4,3,2,1.
4. Champion Tie-Breakers – In the Beginner Divisions, most points in Equitation wins.  
In Hunter divisions, most points over fences wins. Hack division, Management will flip a coin for the Champion ribbon & prize. Jumper division, most points in STAKE class wins
5. Champion & Reserve ribbons are both awarded with a prize.
6. Stake money will be paid in divisions with 6 or more entries where the rider has competed in the entire division.
7. Stake Prize Money – 1st \$60.00, 2nd \$50.00, 3rd \$30.00, 4th \$24.00, 5th \$20.00, 6th \$16.00
8. The year-end standing/Ranking points will be determined using the following formula: Placing in the class (as stipulated below) multiplied by the number of horses competing in the class: 1st place - 8 points, 2nd place - 7 points, 3rd Place - 6 points, 4th Place - 5 points, 5th Place - 4 points, 6th Place - 3 points, 7th Place - 2 points, 8th Place - 1 point

## **STALLS**

# **RULES & REGULATIONS CONT'D**

For those who are renting our stalls, these are the stall rules -

1. All stalls are to be booked with your entry on SGL. Stalls are to be assigned to the horse, no stall sharing allowed.
2. Any stalls booked longer than a day like overnight & day stall or 1st Day & 2nd Day stall per entry, stalls are required to be cleaned by exhibitor, must bring your own supplies to clean stalls. Please keep your area clean! Any stalls that are excessively dirty upon departure will be charged a cleaning stall fee of \$30+hst.
3. Any stalls booked longer than a day per entry, horses can stay during the duration during the time the stalls are booked. Stalls will NOT be cleaned out if booked longer than a day stall, exhibitors must clean their own stall during the time of rental.
4. ONLY Single DAY STALLS (1st Day Stall or 2nd Day Stall) will be cleaned in-between days (arrival 2 hours prior to start of show day, departure 30 minutes after show is finished for the day)
5. Stalls will be initially bedded with shavings, shavings bags are available to be purchased if needed. Hay is also available to purchase as well.
6. Overnight stalls start at 3pm (please make arrangements with office if earlier time is needed)
7. Remember as always, any stalls booked must provide vaccination paperwork for horses stabling via email.
8. Trainers can add hay, shavings, tack stalls to their trainer account on SGL and can be split between entries, please notify the office if splits are required otherwise trainer will be responsible for fees on their account at end of show.
9. We do not provide water buckets, hooks, clips, hay nets, cleaning supplies like pitchforks, wheelbarrow for stalls.
10. Stalls, shaving bags & hay bales are non-refundable after due date.
11. Keep doors/doorways clear for fire emergencies.
12. Do not hang anything (buckets, hay nets, etc.) on stall bars or gates.
13. Recommend over-the-door bucket hooks for buckets or attach to cross tie rings.
14. One horse per stall.
15. Only horses renting stalls are allowed in the barns.
16. Any damages done to the stall will be charged to credit card on file.

## **BIO-SECURITY PROTOCOLS FOR HORSES COMPETING**

1. In light of EHV-1 cases in the surrounding area, we will be requiring supporting documentation for Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus (1&4) vaccination in form of a vet's bill or letter for ALL HORSES RENTING STALLS. The vaccination must be administered not earlier than 12 months of the horse show date, but not within 7 days of the show date. Please email [meadowlarkeshowoffice@gmail.com](mailto:meadowlarkeshowoffice@gmail.com) the supporting documents.
2. We ask all competitors to check your horse's temperature the night before and the morning of Meadowlarke North competition date, it should not be over 38.6 C (F 101.5)
3. If ANY of the horses at your barn, showing or non showing, have a higher than normal temperature, you must not bring ANY horses to Meadowlarke North, please leave ALL horses home.
4. Unless warming-up/showing we ask that you keep your horses time in the arena/ring(s) to a minimum. While waiting for your classes, please either have your horses in your horse trailer or rented stalls.
5. Have horses tacked before entering buildings, and don't bring in any other riding equipment, blankets etc. unless absolutely necessary. This reduces possible contamination of surface areas inside, or, of your equipment.
6. No nose-to-nose contact with other horses that are not from your barn.
7. No sharing equipment between horses not in your barn.
8. Please bring your own water or if using the barn hose don't touch it to your bucket to avoid contamination.
